Rodney was captivated by a trident maple forest in 1973 and has pursued bonsai since. Rodney has worked his magic with bonsai at conventions and conferences all over the US and England, especially with his rock plantings and use of boxwood to recall the live oak style of tree from his childhood in the Florida Panhandle
